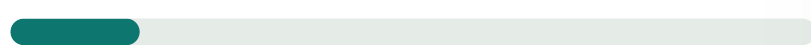

On July 6, 2023, Abdisamad Mohamed Ismail, who had committed multiple armed robberies including a bank robbery and stolen a Porsche at gunpoint, fled police in the stolen vehicle on Interstate 70 in Columbus, Ohio. After the vehicle stopped due to damage, Ismail exited, ambushed responding officers, and shot one officer, causing life-threatening injuries. Eight Columbus Division of Police officers returned fire, striking Ismail, who died at the scene. Two accomplices, Faisal Darod and Aden Jama, fled but were later arrested. The Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation conducted an independent investigation into the shooting.
