Summary of Events

On December 23, 2021, at approximately 0430 hours, the Akron Police Department requested crime scene assistance from the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) regarding an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) shooting at 2470 26th Street, SW, Akron, Ohio. Akron Police conducted the investigation based on consent to search authorized by the female victim resident.

BCI S/A Ed Staley arrived after Akron Police Crime Scene Personnel had photographed and scanned the residence. The specific scene was a second-floor room where the door had been forced; the handle and locking mechanism were found on the floor inside. Inside, S/A Staley observed a deceased Caucasian male lying supine on the floor. Taser wires were noted near

the decedent's neck. Two folding knives were located: one under the decedent's left leg and one near the nightstand.

Upon arrival of the Summit County Medical Examiner's Office, the decedent's hands were bagged. When the body was rolled for removal, a Taser device and a cellular phone were discovered underneath. S/A Staley collected and preserved eight items of evidence, including the Taser device, two knives, two cellular phones, two 9MM cartridge cases (one on the floor, one on the bed), and one copper jacketed bullet recovered from the mattress. All evidence was retained by the Akron Police Department.

Subject(s) Prior Record

Not stated in source.

Most Important Uncertainty

The document does not identify the officer(s) involved in the shooting, the name of the deceased male, or the circumstances leading to the use of force. It is a scene processing report focused solely on physical evidence collection after the incident occurred.
